




NON-ENTRÉE REGIME
















ITALY: ARRIVALS BY SEA








"SPATIAL DISOBEDIENCE"



HOTSPOT IN TARANTO

"Particularly as regards **Taranto** among the 14,576 people transiting through the hotspot from March to October 2016, only 5,048 came from disembarkations while the majority (9,528) were traced on Italian territory, mainly at border places in Ventimiglia, Como and Milan, and forcibly taken to Taranto to be identified."

COMMUNIQUE DE PRESSE

Lundi 7 mai, aux alentours de 5h du matin, un groupe composé de trois personnes étrangères, dont deux hommes et une jeune femme, marchaient en suivant la nationale 94 en direction de Briançon. La jeune femme marchait difficilement du fait de douleurs aux jambes et était souvent aidée par les deux jeunes hommes. À la hauteur du hameau de La Vachette, 5 policiers dissimulés dans les fourrés ont surgis brusquement sur la route nationale en allumant des torches électriques et en criant « police, police ». Les 3 personnes étrangères se sont alors enfuies à travers champ en direction du village où elles se sont dispersées, poursuivies par les policiers. L'un des deux hommes est interpellé vers l'Eglise. Les policiers sillonnent ensuite le village pendant plusieurs heures. La jeune femme ne donne plus aucune nouvelle d'elle depuis ce jour. En toutes hypothèses, les 5 policiers sont les dernières personnes à avoir vu vivante la jeune femme disparue. Mercredi 9 mai, le corps d'une jeune femme est retrouvée dans la Durance une dizaine de kilomètres plus en aval.
